For this summer, KU Leuven's [Faculty of Economics & Business](#) (FEB) proposes a new summer course that focuses on entrepreneurship and innovation. You chose the 3- or the 6-ECTS version:

- one week of visits to firms and institutions related to entrepreneurship and innovation, including a tech transfer office, a venture capitalist, and a trip to the OECD in Paris, topped up with a few courses on financial issues in Europe; transcript for 3 ECTS credits
- a second, optional week where students can do supervised research on a topic touched upon by the course; transcript for 3 extra ECTS credits

Students from school or colleges with an exchange agreement with KU Leuven's FEB receive an extra discount on top of the early-bird advantage. Groups can negotiate special terms; just mail to [piet.sercu@kuleuven.be](mailto:piet.sercu@kuleuven.be).

**Further possible extensions:** groups, if any, might add a travel week instead of the research week, or perhaps even as their third week, and we can help with such plans. One suggestion is to cover, in six days, six international institutions at The Hague, Luxembourg and Strasbourg. But London, Paris, Cologne and Amsterdam, are just 1.5 or 2 hours away by train, so the options are many.
