It's our pleasure to announce the third edition of our **Europe Inside Out** Summer School, a joint offer by KU's Faculties of Arts, Economics and Business, and Social Sciences. This year's edition will run from May 19 till May 29, 2015. Most classes take place in Leuven, an absolutely great university town where 600 years of academic tradition go hand in hand with a thirst for knowledge, research and innovation and a vibrant social scene; but the programme also exploits the close proximity of Brussels (just a 20-minute train ride away) to visit some European institutions, includes day trips to Paris and Antwerp, and adds an optional visit to two medieval gems, Bruges and Ypres. (If still in doubt, *do* watch the movie "In Bruges".)

In addition to the multidisciplinary core classes, students select two modules from a menu of four: European Politics and Policies, Doing Business in Europe, Innovation and Entrepreneurship in Europe, Social and Demographic Issues in Europe. An optional one-week mini research project can be added that results in a supervised and graded paper.
