Program Fees	RMB 63,000 (including application fee, tuition, case fee)
Accommodation	On-campus accommodation is currently NOT available due to the overwhelming demand. A limited number of rooms are available to apply. Information will be confirmed after admission.

Living Expenses	Depends on your living situation and your own spending habits. Normally amounts to US\$350 – 450 per month, excluding housing.
Health Insurance	Students are required to purchase the travel insurance which should at least cover local medical treatment and personal accident for the whole semester.
Facilities	State of the art library services, computer facilities, cafés, on-campus restaurants, student clubs, bookstores, gyms.
